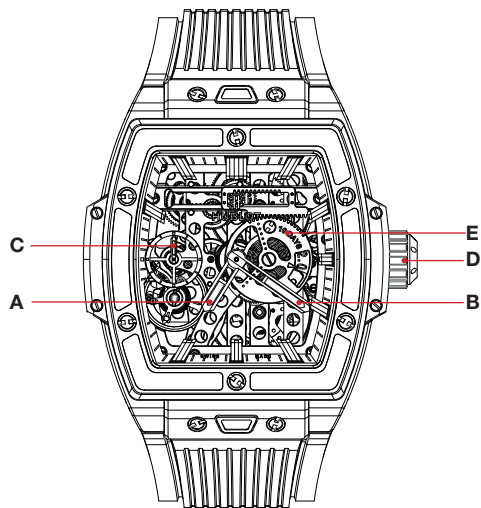

This fundamental concept makes your watch a unique timepiece. As you turn this page, you will enter the world of the BIG BANG MECA-10.





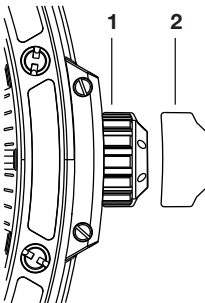
WINDING

Position 1

This function accumulates the energy required by your watch to run properly.

Crown positions:

1. Winding (neutral position)
2. Time setting

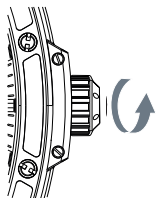




WINDING

Position 1

USE



Manual-winding

Make sure that the crown is in the neutral position. That means that the crown is pushed in – as close to the watch case as possible.

Take the crown between your thumb and index finger and start rotating the crown clockwise until you'll feel some resistance.



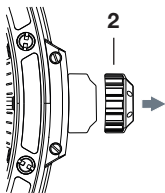


TIME SETTING

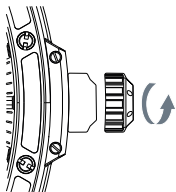
Position 2

This function enables you to set the time of your watch using the crown.

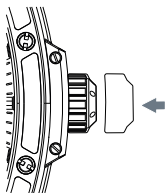
USE



1. Pull the crown out to position 2.



2. Then turn the crown either way to set the hour and minute hands to the desired time.



3. Press the crown back in completely against the case.





POWER RESERVE

INDICATOR

The MECA-10 movement (HUB1201) is fitted with two parallel barrels with a power reserve indicator using a rack system.

At 12 o'clock, two racks slide on a 9 o'clock to 3 o'clock axis thanks to a rack and pinion system.

At 6 o'clock, a crown gear marked from 0 to 10 indicates the remaining days of the power reserve.

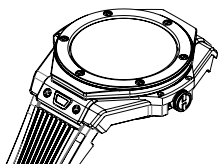


“ONE CLICK” SYSTEM

Your Hublot timepiece features an interchangeable “One Click” system which allows you to change your strap and the buckle with great ease.

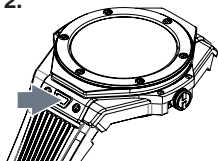
1. Neutral position



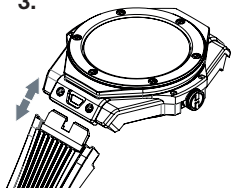
Detaching the strap from the watch head:

Press the buttons located at 6 o'clock and 12 o'clock on the watch head (diagram 2) then pull the strap away from the watch head to detach the strap (diagram 3).

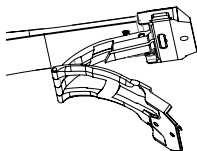
Attaching the strap to the watch head:

Gently insert the metal part of the strap into the space provided in the watch head until you hear a click (diagram 3).

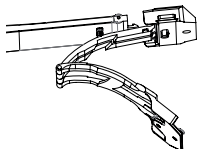

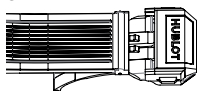

Detaching the bracelet from the watch head:

Press the button on the back of the buckle (diagram 1) then pull the bracelet away from the buckle to detach the bracelet (diagram 2 and 3).

Attaching the buckle to the bracelet:

Gently insert the tab for the “One Click” spring attached to the end of the bracelet (diagram 3 and 4) into the space provided in the buckle until you hear a click (diagram 3).

If you would like to wear a Hublot strap with your Hublot timepiece which is not the one originally provided, and which does not have a «One Click» attachment (diagram 4), you can change the attachment yourself using the tab lugat the top right (diagram 4).

HUBLOT INTERNATIONAL GUARANTEE

Manufactured in the purest Swiss watchmaking tradition, your Hublot watch has been individually tested to ensure its optimal functioning and water resistance. An international warranty covers your watch against any manufacturing defects (the "**International Warranty**") under the terms and conditions described below.

All Hublot watches purchased from our official network, whether in one of our boutiques, from one of our authorized retailers, or on our e-commerce site (our "**Official Network**") are covered by this International Warranty.

International Warranty Period

- **For watches (excluding *HUBLOT Certified Pre-Owned watches*) purchased through our Official Network starting January 1, 2026:** Your watch is covered by an international warranty for **five (5) years** from the date of purchase.
- **For all other watches purchased through our Official Network:** Your watch is covered by an international warranty for **two (2) years** from the date of purchase. This specifically concerns:
 - Watches purchased on or before December 31, 2025.
 - All smartwatches, regardless of their date of purchase.
 - All *HUBLOT Certified Pre-Owned watches*, regardless of their date of purchase.

What the International Warranty covers

Hublot undertakes to repair any malfunction of your watch resulting from a manufacturing defect free of charge. Replacement of the battery in a quartz watch will be provided free of charge. It is important to note that battery replacement service does not cover the overall condition or other functions of the watch and does not imply that no other service is required.

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This International Warranty will only be valid throughout our Official Network and in authorized Hublot Service Centers, regardless of the country in which your watch was purchased. What the International Warranty does not cover

The following are expressly excluded from the International Warranty:

- any defect or damage resulting from improper or abnormal use, an accident (e.g., scratches, impacts, dents, damage, or crushing of the case, glass, bracelet, or buckle, etc.), incorrect use of the watch, contact with aggressive or corrosive substances (e.g., acids, solvents, inappropriate cleaning products), or failure to follow the instructions for use and maintenance provided by Hublot;
- defects or damage resulting from service, handling, modification, or repair carried out anywhere other than at a Hublot boutique, an authorized Hublot retailer, or a Hublot Service Center, or through the use of components and/or accessories other than those recommended by Hublot;
- wear and tear due to normal use and aging of your watch, including any wear on surfaces due to normal use, scratches on the case, strap, crystal, or buckle, damage to surfaces, or contact with chemicals;

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- any defect resulting from contact with water if the watch has not been used in accordance with its water resistance specifications, if the crown or push-pieces were not properly closed, or if the water resistance tests recommended by Hublot have not been carried out regularly or by a Hublot boutique, an authorized Hublot retailer, or an authorized Hublot Service Center;
- Hublot watches and components that are not absolutely authentic;
- any watch that Hublot suspects has been lost or stolen. As such, Hublot reserves the right to refuse warranty coverage for any watch that has been reported as lost or stolen, including, but not limited to, if it is listed in a database of lost and stolen products.

What are the terms and conditions of the International Warranty?

To be covered by this International Warranty, the following conditions must be met:

- your watch must be covered by a valid international warranty at the time of the service request;
- the serial number engraved on the case must be perfectly legible, and no part of the case back or original serial number must have been removed, modified, falsified, altered, replaced, erased, damaged, or rendered illegible.

Failure to comply with the above conditions will render the International Warranty null and void.

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Limitations of terms and conditions

The International Warranty does not affect any other rights you may have under applicable national legislation, which may vary depending on the country where you purchased your Hublot watch. The International Warranty does not exclude, modify, or reduce these statutory rights. For a complete understanding of your rights, we encourage you to consult the laws of your country.



RECOMMENDATIONS & CARE

The constituent parts of your Hublot watch are all of the finest quality, and inspected under extremely stringent criteria. They combine to form a piece with exceptional water resistance, with certain models capable of reaching a depth of 4000 meters. To preserve these qualities, we recommend a complete overhaul every 3 to 5 years, since temperature variations, humidity, perspiration and repeated shocks may affect its water resistance as the years go by.

With its water resistant case and rubber, ceramic or carbon strap, or gold or steel bracelet, your Hublot watch can be washed easily. If the watch has an alligator strap, you are advised to take it off when bathing. Clean it regularly in lukewarm soapy water, rinsing and wiping down carefully with a soft cloth. After wearing your Hublot watch in seawater, please rinse it in fresh water.
