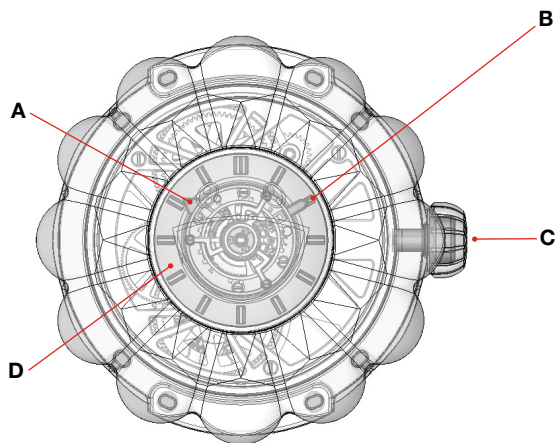

INTRODUCTION

Your MP-15 is the first Hublot watch in a limited series equipped with a central flying tourbillon, different from anything the Manufacture has produced over 40 years. Hublot merges case, movement, and dial into an exceptional composition. To maximize the luminous character of its MP-15, Hublot has worked on absolute transparency: sapphire case, sapphire back, sapphire crown, translucent flange and strap. Surrounding this are the iconic motifs of Takashi Murakami — a flower with 12 petals, all executed in sapphire.

This central tourbillon is powered by an impressive power reserve of at least 120 hours or nearly an entire week — an exceptional technical feat for this type of complication. For fully winding it up again, Hublot designed a stylus specifically dedicated to this purpose. Provided with the piece for which it was specially conceived and rechargeable via USB, it attaches to the crown to then wind it smoothly and effortlessly for 100 rotations until full winding of both barrels that animate the central tourbillon.

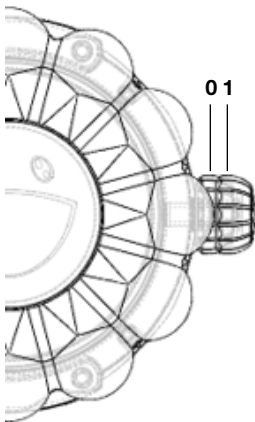
Encircling this central tourbillon are hour and minute hands displayed by two hand tips; they are not centered but peripheral instead. The technical challenge: they literally pass under the cage of the tourbillon defying basic principles of traditional horological science. Here at this singular central spot compete the escapement along with hour and minute hands for dominance. Hublot has also designed its tourbillon without an upper bridge; all its components are skeletonized.

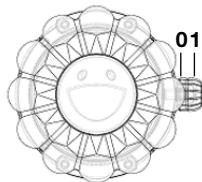

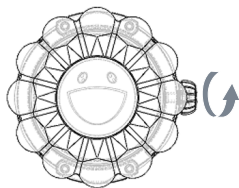
This function accumulates the energy required by your watch to run properly.

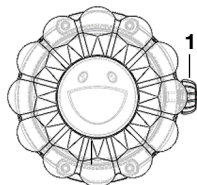


Manual winding and power-reserve

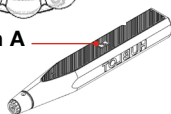
Your Hublot MP-15 TAKASHI MURAKAMI TOURBILLON watch is equipped with a manual-winding tourbillon movement and offers a power reserve of at least 120 hours, which is nearly an entire week.



For the proper functioning of the watch, it is recommended to wind it every 5 days. This can be done manually by turning the crown clockwise until you feel a slight resistance at the end of winding. Alternatively, you can use the provided PC.915.UX tool by fitting it onto the crown's end and then pressing button A; the tool will then wind the crown until both barrels are fully wound, which animate the central tourbillon. A complete winding is equivalent to 105 turns of the crown.



Button A



To perform this winding operation, ensure that the crown is in position 0.

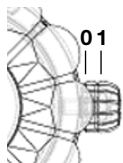




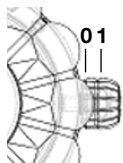
TIME SETTING

This function enables you to set the time of your watch using the crown.

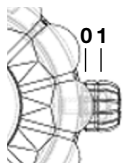
USE



1. Pull out the crown (C) to position 1.



2. Turn the crown (C) clockwise until you reach the desired time.



3. Push the crown (C) back to position 0.



HUBLOT INTERNATIONAL GUARANTEE

Manufactured in the purest Swiss watchmaking tradition, your Hublot watch has been individually tested to ensure its optimal functioning and water resistance. An international warranty covers your watch against any manufacturing defects (the "**International Warranty**") under the terms and conditions described below.

All Hublot watches purchased from our official network, whether in one of our boutiques, from one of our authorized retailers, or on our e-commerce site (our "**Official Network**") are covered by this International Warranty.

International Warranty Period

- **For watches (excluding *HUBLOT Certified Pre-Owned watches*) purchased through our Official Network starting January 1, 2026:** Your watch is covered by an international warranty for **five (5) years** from the date of purchase.
- **For all other watches purchased through our Official Network:** Your watch is covered by an international warranty for **two (2) years** from the date of purchase. This specifically concerns:
 - Watches purchased on or before December 31, 2025.
 - All smartwatches, regardless of their date of purchase.
 - All *HUBLOT Certified Pre-Owned watches*, regardless of their date of purchase.

What the International Warranty covers

Hublot undertakes to repair any malfunction of your watch resulting from a manufacturing defect free of charge. Replacement of the battery in a quartz watch will be provided free of charge. It is important to note that battery replacement service does not cover the overall condition or other functions of the watch and does not imply that no other service is required.

HUBLOT INTERNATIONAL GUARANTEE

This International Warranty will only be valid throughout our Official Network and in authorized Hublot Service Centers, regardless of the country in which your watch was purchased. What the International Warranty does not cover

The following are expressly excluded from the International Warranty:

- any defect or damage resulting from improper or abnormal use, an accident (e.g., scratches, impacts, dents, damage, or crushing of the case, glass, bracelet, or buckle, etc.), incorrect use of the watch, contact with aggressive or corrosive substances (e.g., acids, solvents, inappropriate cleaning products), or failure to follow the instructions for use and maintenance provided by Hublot;
- defects or damage resulting from service, handling, modification, or repair carried out anywhere other than at a Hublot boutique, an authorized Hublot retailer, or a Hublot Service Center, or through the use of components and/or accessories other than those recommended by Hublot;
- wear and tear due to normal use and aging of your watch, including any wear on surfaces due to normal use, scratches on the case, strap, crystal, or buckle, damage to surfaces, or contact with chemicals;

HUBLOT INTERNATIONAL GUARANTEE

- any defect resulting from contact with water if the watch has not been used in accordance with its water resistance specifications, if the crown or push-pieces were not properly closed, or if the water resistance tests recommended by Hublot have not been carried out regularly or by a Hublot boutique, an authorized Hublot retailer, or an authorized Hublot Service Center;
- Hublot watches and components that are not absolutely authentic;
- any watch that Hublot suspects has been lost or stolen. As such, Hublot reserves the right to refuse warranty coverage for any watch that has been reported as lost or stolen, including, but not limited to, if it is listed in a database of lost and stolen products.

What are the terms and conditions of the International Warranty?

To be covered by this International Warranty, the following conditions must be met:

- your watch must be covered by a valid international warranty at the time of the service request;
- the serial number engraved on the case must be perfectly legible, and no part of the case back or original serial number must have been removed, modified, falsified, altered, replaced, erased, damaged, or rendered illegible.

Failure to comply with the above conditions will render the International Warranty null and void.

Limitations of terms and conditions

The International Warranty does not affect any other rights you may have under applicable national legislation, which may vary depending on the country where you purchased your Hublot watch. The International Warranty does not exclude, modify, or reduce these statutory rights. For a complete understanding of your rights, we encourage you to consult the laws of your country.



RECOMMENDATIONS & CARE

The constituent parts of your Hublot watch are all of the finest quality, and inspected under extremely stringent criteria. They combine to form a piece with exceptional water resistance, with certain models capable of reaching a depth of 4000 meters. To preserve these qualities, we recommend a complete overhaul every 3 to 5 years, since temperature variations, humidity, perspiration and repeated shocks may affect its water resistance as the years go by.

With its water resistant case and rubber, ceramic or carbon strap, or gold or steel bracelet, your Hublot watch can be washed easily. If the watch has an alligator strap, you are advised to take it off when bathing. Clean it regularly in lukewarm soapy water, rinsing and wiping down carefully with a soft cloth. After wearing your Hublot watch in seawater, please rinse it in fresh water.
