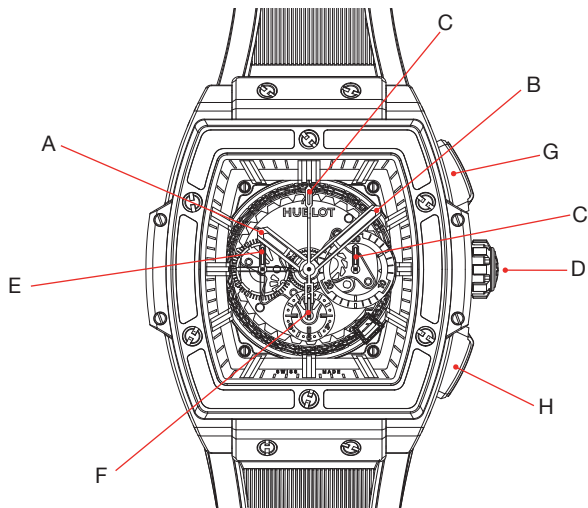

This fundamental concept makes your watch a unique timepiece. As you turn this page, you will enter the world of the Spirit of Big Bang.

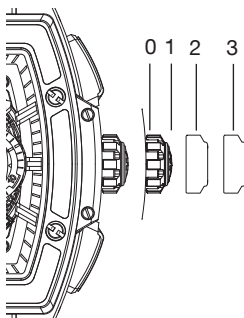


QUICK START

CROWN FUNCTIONS

Crown positions:

- 0. Screw-in crown
- 1. Winding
- 2. Time setting
- 3. Date setting





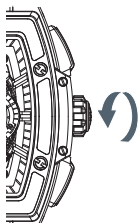
SCREW-IN CROWN

Position 0

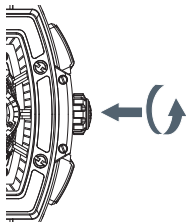
This type of crown offers excellent protection to ensure the case's water resistance.

The crown has to be unscrewed before any operation and must be screwed back in fully afterwards.

USE



1. Unscrew the crown before any operation.



2. Press the crown firmly against the case while screwing it back in.

Occasionally, check that the crown is screwed in correctly.



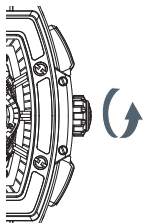


WINDING

Position 1

This function accumulates the energy required by your watch to run properly.

USE



Self-winding

This term means that your watch automatically stores the energy generated by your arm movements when the watch is worn on your wrist.

If your watch has not been worn for some time and has stopped, you must wind it manually by rotating the crown clockwise through approximately ten turns. See drawing.

Spirit of Big Bang watches have a power reserve of 50 hours.

Do not forget to screw the crown back in completely to ensure its water resistance.





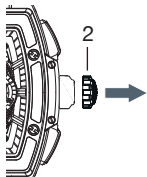
TIME SETTING

Position 2

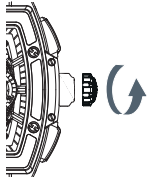
This function enables you to set the time of your watch using the crown.

When performing this operation, make sure that the calendar date change is at midnight and not at midday.

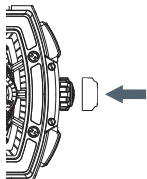
USE



1. Pull the crown out to position 2, at the exact moment when the seconds hand is at the 12 o'clock position; the hand will then stop.



2. Then turn the crown either way to set the hour and minute hands to the desired time.



3. Press the crown back in completely against the case; the watch will restart.

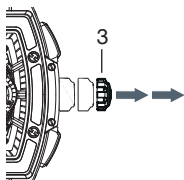
Do not forget to screw the crown back in completely to ensure its water resistance.



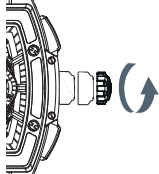
Position 3

This function enables you to set the date displayed by the watch rapidly, without changing the time, using only the crown.

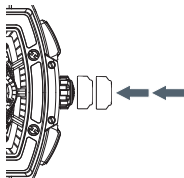
It is strongly recommended not to make this correction between 8 pm and 1 am, as the calendar disc is “engaged” during this period, so the operation might damage the mechanism.

USE

1. Pull the crown out to position 3.



2. Turn the crown clockwise (or anti-clockwise, according to the model) until the desired date appears in the window.



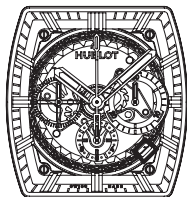
3. Press the crown back in completely against the case.

Do not forget to screw the crown back in completely to ensure its water resistance.



CHRONOGRAPH

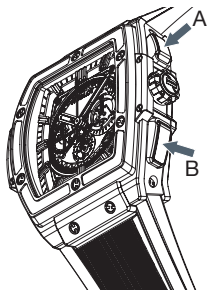
The chronograph function enables you to measure a time.



The dial features 3 counters:

The hour counter is at the bottom, and the minute counter on the right; the left-hand counter shows the elapsing time, and the seconds are counted by the central direct-drive hand.

USE



Before timing, make sure that the chronograph centre hand (direct-drive), and the minute and hour counter hands have been reset. Then:

1. Press push-piece (A): the chronograph hand will start instantly.
2. When the event ends, press push-piece (A): the hand will stop and display the exact elapsed time.
3. Press push-piece (B): the direct-drive hand and counter hands will be reset.

To measure a series of sequential times: press push-piece (A) again to restart the hands.

N.B.: the chronograph can only be reset if it has first been stopped by pressing push-piece (A).



HUBLOT INTERNATIONAL GUARANTEE

Manufactured in the purest Swiss watchmaking tradition, your Hublot watch has been individually tested to ensure its optimal functioning and water resistance. An international warranty covers your watch against any manufacturing defects (the "International Warranty") under the terms and conditions described below.

All Hublot watches purchased from our official network, whether in one of our boutiques, from one of our authorized retailers, or on our e-commerce site (our "Official Network") are covered by this International Warranty.

International Warranty Period

- For watches (excluding **HUBLOT Certified Pre-Owned watches**) purchased through our Official Network starting January 1, 2026: Your watch is covered by an international warranty for five (5) years from the date of purchase.
- For all other watches purchased through our Official Network: Your watch is covered by an international warranty for two (2) years from the date of purchase. This specifically concerns:
 - Watches purchased on or before December 31, 2025.
 - All smartwatches, regardless of their date of purchase.
 - All *HUBLOT Certified Pre-Owned watches*, regardless of their date of purchase.

What the International Warranty covers

Hublot undertakes to repair any malfunction of your watch resulting from a manufacturing defect free of charge. Replacement of the battery in a quartz watch will be provided free of charge. It is important to note that battery replacement service does not cover the overall condition or other functions of the watch and does not imply that no other service is required.

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This International Warranty will only be valid throughout our Official Network and in authorized Hublot Service Centers, regardless of the country in which your watch was purchased. What the International Warranty does not cover

The following are expressly excluded from the International Warranty:

- any defect or damage resulting from improper or abnormal use, an accident (e.g., scratches, impacts, dents, damage, or crushing of the case, glass, bracelet, or buckle, etc.), incorrect use of the watch, contact with aggressive or corrosive substances (e.g., acids, solvents, inappropriate cleaning products), or failure to follow the instructions for use and maintenance provided by Hublot;
- defects or damage resulting from service, handling, modification, or repair carried out anywhere other than at a Hublot boutique, an authorized Hublot retailer, or a Hublot Service Center, or through the use of components and/or accessories other than those recommended by Hublot;
- wear and tear due to normal use and aging of your watch, including any wear on surfaces due to normal use, scratches on the case, strap, crystal, or buckle, damage to surfaces, or contact with chemicals;

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- any defect resulting from contact with water if the watch has not been used in accordance with its water resistance specifications, if the crown or push-pieces were not properly closed, or if the water resistance tests recommended by Hublot have not been carried out regularly or by a Hublot boutique, an authorized Hublot retailer, or an authorized Hublot Service Center;
- Hublot watches and components that are not absolutely authentic;
- any watch that Hublot suspects has been lost or stolen. As such, Hublot reserves the right to refuse warranty coverage for any watch that has been reported as lost or stolen, including, but not limited to, if it is listed in a database of lost and stolen products.

What are the terms and conditions of the International Warranty?

To be covered by this International Warranty, the following conditions must be met:

- your watch must be covered by a valid international warranty at the time of the service request;
- the serial number engraved on the case must be perfectly legible, and no part of the case back or original serial number must have been removed, modified, falsified, altered, replaced, erased, damaged, or rendered illegible.

Failure to comply with the above conditions will render the International Warranty null and void.

Limitations of terms and conditions

The International Warranty does not affect any other rights you may have under applicable national legislation, which may vary depending on the country where you purchased your Hublot watch. The International Warranty does not exclude, modify, or reduce these statutory rights. For a complete understanding of your rights, we encourage you to consult the laws of your country.
