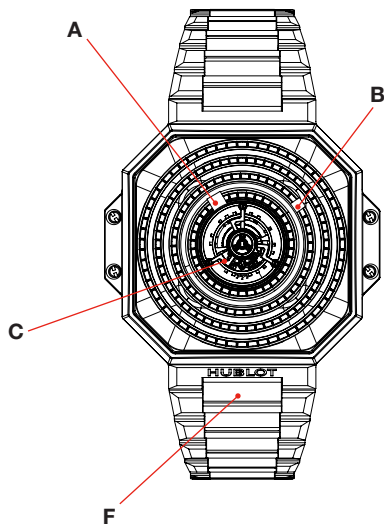

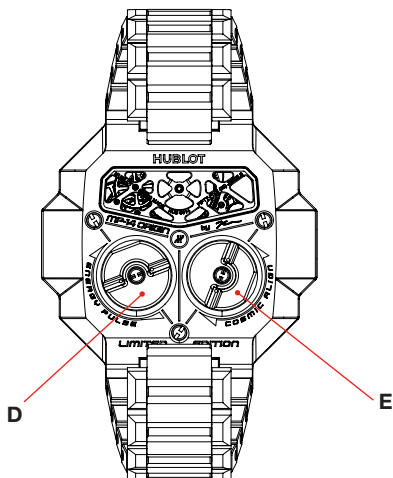

INTRODUCTION

The MP-14 Origin by Jeff Koons joins Hublot's Exceptional Timepieces collection, an experimental laboratory dedicated to radical mechanical concepts, advanced materials and unconventional time architectures.

Conceived as a horological interpretation of the origin of motion, the watch unfolds through a concentric construction in which energy appears to emerge from a single center before expanding throughout the entire volume of the piece. The central tourbillon acts as the originating impulse, while the display rings revolve around it like suspended orbits.

This creation combines:

- a transparent sapphire case of exceptional machining complexity
- a gem-set concentric construction
- a central automatic manufacture tourbillon movement
- a visual architecture designed to preserve openness, depth and levitation

Limited to 30 pieces, the MP-14 Origin by Jeff Koons expresses the meeting of Jeff Koons' artistic vision and Hublot's technical mastery.

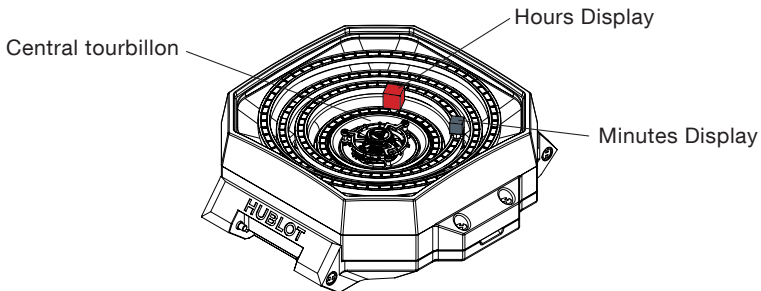


QUICK START

The MP-14 Origin by Jeff Koons replaces conventional hands with an openwork, concentric display where indications appear to orbit around the mechanical center.

Time is read intuitively through two suspended floating cubes and two fixed reference rings:

- **Hours Display:** Indicated by the floating red cube, which travels along the inner suspended ring. The fixed ring set with blue sapphires features distinct hour markers.
- **Minutes Display:** Indicated by the floating grey cube, which travels along the outer suspended ring. The fixed sapphire ring features distinct quarter markers.
- **The Center:** The central tourbillon acts as the core of the movement, around which all time displays revolve.



HOW TO READ THE TIME

Time is displayed through two suspended rotating rings:

- One for the hours
- One for the minutes

The floating markers allow for intuitive time reading within the concentric architecture of the watch. Specifically, time is read using two suspended indicator cubes:

- The red cube indicates the hours.
- The grey cube indicates the minutes.

The fixed rings, set with blue sapphires, serve as complementary visual references:

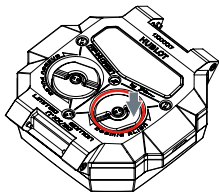
- Hour markers for the hours.
- Quarter-hour markers for the minutes.

This unique construction creates a spatial reading of time, with the indications appearing to orbit around the mechanical center.

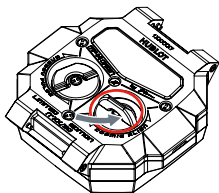


TIME SETTING

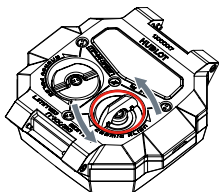
USE



0. Neutral position: The system remains inactive, with the concealed bail folded flat against the case back.



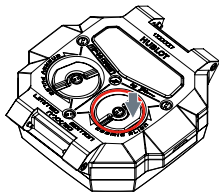
1. Locate and activate the control: Turn the watch over to view the case back. Locate the concealed control identified by the COSMIC ALIGN engraving (the bail located on the right side). Activate the time-setting function by lifting this half-moon bail into a perpendicular position to unlock the mechanism.



2. Adjust the time: Turn the perpendicular bail in either direction (clockwise or counter-clockwise) to rotate the suspended hour and minute rings. Advance the display until the desired time is reached and correctly indicated by the floating cubes.



TIME SETTING

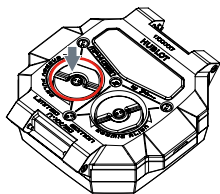


3. Lock and return to neutral: Once the setting is complete, return the system to its initial position by folding the bail back down flat against the case back. This locks the time setting, prevents accidental adjustments, and ensures comfortable wear on the wrist.

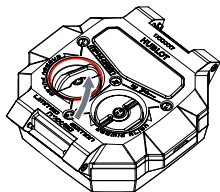
Note: Always set the time gently in order to preserve the precision of the mechanism and the integrity of the concealed setting components.

WINDING (ENERGY PULSE)

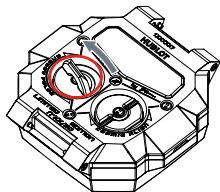
The MP-14 Origin by Jeff Koons is fitted with the HUB9014 automatic manufacture movement, featuring a central tourbillon and a peripheral oscillating mass. The movement offers a power reserve of approximately 60 hours when fully wound.



0. Neutral position: The system rests flush within the case architecture, with the concealed bail folded flat against the case back.

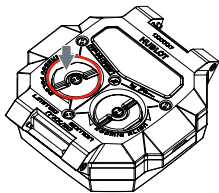


1. Locate and activate the control: Turn the watch over to view the case back. Locate the control identified by the ENERGY PULSE engraving (the bail located on the left side). Activate the winding system by lifting this half-moon bail into a perpendicular position to engage the mechanism.



2. Wind the movement: Turn the perpendicular bail strictly clockwise (this mechanism is designed to rotate in one direction only) to wind the HUB9014 manufacture movement and build up the 60-hour power reserve. Proceed with smooth and measured movements until a sufficient level of manual winding is achieved.

WINDING



3. Lock and return to neutral: Once the watch is wound, fold the bail back down flat into its neutral position, flush against the case back, to secure the mechanism and ensure comfortable wear.

The automatic system (via the peripheral oscillating mass) will then maintain the winding level while the watch is worn on the wrist.

Note: Always avoid abrupt or excessive handling. If the watch has not been worn for several days and has stopped, preliminary manual winding using the ENERGY PULSE control is recommended before wearing it again.



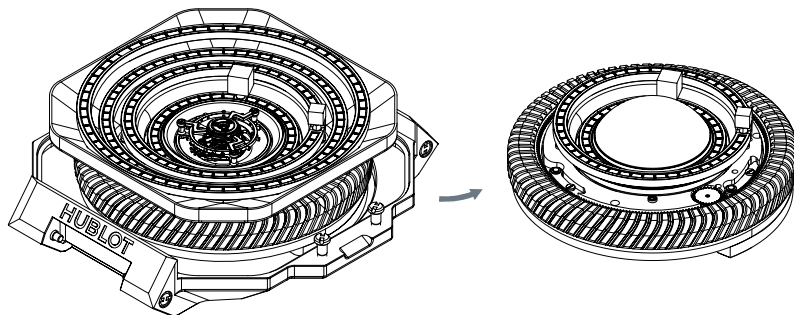


POWER RESERVE

The HUB9014 manufacture movement powering the MP-14 Origin by Jeff Koons is equipped with an automatic central tourbillon and a peripheral oscillating weight system, delivering a power reserve of approximately 60 hours.

While traditional power reserve displays appear on the dial or case-back, the MP-14 integrates its energy management directly into its kinetic architecture:

- **Peripheral Winding System:** The peripheral oscillating mass ensures continuous energy efficiency while keeping the multi-layered sapphire and white gold architecture fully open and unobstructed.
- **Energy Flow:** The mechanism acts as a controlled cosmic expansion, where the central tourbillon serves as the initial pulse distributing energy evenly across the suspended orbital rings.

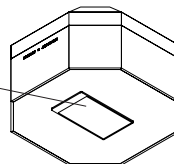


WATCH BOX

The watch is delivered in a presentation case conceived as an immersive visual installation. Inspired by the octagonal geometry of the timepiece, it combines LED lighting, one-way mirror effects and a transparent dome to extend the watch's spatial and perceptual experience.

POWER SUPPLY

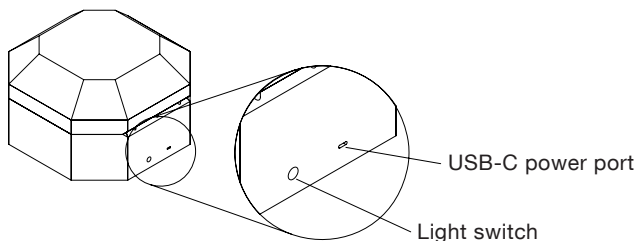
- 6x AA Batteries (not included): Cordless operation.
- USB-C: Continuous power via the rear input port.



ILLUMINATION

Light switch located on the rear.

- Battery Mode: Press to activate. Automatic shut-off after 30 seconds. Light switch on the back of the watch box (see view below).
- USB-C Powered Mode: Manual ON / OFF switch. Press to toggle. Light switch on the back of the watch box (see view below).



HUBLOT INTERNATIONAL GUARANTEE

Manufactured in the purest Swiss watchmaking tradition, your Hublot watch has been individually tested to ensure its optimal functioning and water resistance. An international warranty covers your watch against any manufacturing defects (the "**International Warranty**") under the terms and conditions described below.

All Hublot watches purchased from our official network, whether in one of our boutiques, from one of our authorized retailers, or on our e-commerce site (our "**Official Network**") are covered by this International Warranty.

International Warranty Period

- **For watches (excluding *HUBLOT Certified Pre-Owned watches*) purchased through our Official Network starting January 1, 2026:** Your watch is covered by an international warranty for **five (5) years** from the date of purchase.
- **For all other watches purchased through our Official Network:** Your watch is covered by an international warranty for **two (2) years** from the date of purchase. This specifically concerns:
 - Watches purchased on or before December 31, 2025.
 - All smartwatches, regardless of their date of purchase.
 - All *HUBLOT Certified Pre-Owned watches*, regardless of their date of purchase.

What the International Warranty covers

Hublot undertakes to repair any malfunction of your watch resulting from a manufacturing defect free of charge. Replacement of the battery in a quartz watch will be provided free of charge. It is important to note that battery replacement service does not cover the overall condition or other functions of the watch and does not imply that no other service is required.

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This International Warranty will only be valid throughout our Official Network and in authorized Hublot Service Centers, regardless of the country in which your watch was purchased. What the International Warranty does not cover

The following are expressly excluded from the International Warranty:

- any defect or damage resulting from improper or abnormal use, an accident (e.g., scratches, impacts, dents, damage, or crushing of the case, glass, bracelet, or buckle, etc.), incorrect use of the watch, contact with aggressive or corrosive substances (e.g., acids, solvents, inappropriate cleaning products), or failure to follow the instructions for use and maintenance provided by Hublot;
- defects or damage resulting from service, handling, modification, or repair carried out anywhere other than at a Hublot boutique, an authorized Hublot retailer, or a Hublot Service Center, or through the use of components and/or accessories other than those recommended by Hublot;
- wear and tear due to normal use and aging of your watch, including any wear on surfaces due to normal use, scratches on the case, strap, crystal, or buckle, damage to surfaces, or contact with chemicals;

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- any defect resulting from contact with water if the watch has not been used in accordance with its water resistance specifications, if the crown or push-pieces were not properly closed, or if the water resistance tests recommended by Hublot have not been carried out regularly or by a Hublot boutique, an authorized Hublot retailer, or an authorized Hublot Service Center;
- Hublot watches and components that are not absolutely authentic;
- any watch that Hublot suspects has been lost or stolen. As such, Hublot reserves the right to refuse warranty coverage for any watch that has been reported as lost or stolen, including, but not limited to, if it is listed in a database of lost and stolen products.

What are the terms and conditions of the International Warranty?

To be covered by this International Warranty, the following conditions must be met:

- your watch must be covered by a valid international warranty at the time of the service request;
- the serial number engraved on the case must be perfectly legible, and no part of the case back or original serial number must have been removed, modified, falsified, altered, replaced, erased, damaged, or rendered illegible.

Failure to comply with the above conditions will render the International Warranty null and void.

Limitations of terms and conditions

The International Warranty does not affect any other rights you may have under applicable national legislation, which may vary depending on the country where you purchased your Hublot watch. The International Warranty does not exclude, modify, or reduce these statutory rights. For a complete understanding of your rights, we encourage you to consult the laws of your country.



RECOMMENDATIONS & CARE

To preserve the aesthetic and mechanical qualities of your watch, it is recommended to:

- handle the piece with care, especially the sapphire elements
- avoid shocks, twisting and unnecessary pressure
- protect the watch from chemicals, solvents, perfumes and cosmetics
- clean surfaces gently with a soft, non-abrasive cloth
- have the watch inspected regularly by Hublot or an authorized service center

Given the complexity of its construction, any technical intervention must be carried out exclusively by a professional authorized by the brand.

Cleaning

For routine care:

1. use a clean, soft cloth
2. gently wipe the case, bracelet and sapphire surfaces
3. do not use hard brushes or abrasive products

Note: as no confirmed water-resistance information is included in the source material provided, avoid immersion or prolonged exposure to water.

Servicing

Like any High Horology timepiece, the MP-14 Origin by Jeff Koons requires periodic inspection in order to maintain its performance, precision and long-term reliability.
